FIRST TMC RALLY SINCE ASSEMBLY POLL DEFEAT Will foil BJP's attempts to scare TMC: Mamata

Kolkata, June 2

BACK ON THE streets of Kolkata to protest after the party's shocking and humiliating defeat in the Assembly elections, Trinamool Congress (TMC) chief Mamata Banerjee on Tuesday launched a fierce political counter-offensive, accusing the ruling BJP of trying to "bulldoze the democracy" by attacking and intimidating her party leaders and workers.

Denied permission to protest at the Rani Rashmoni Avenue, the former chief minister reached Esplanade's Y-channel in Central Kolkata around 3 pm, with some of the senior party leaders accompanying her.

"Our MLAs, councillors, and party candidates are being intimidated," Mamata told a surging crowd of party workers amid a heavy deployment of police personnel. Alleging a deep-rooted conspiracy orchestrated from Delhi to dismantle her party, she issued a stern warning to the BJP that such attempts would be "foiled".

"Our MLAs are not being allowed to leave their houses, and police are asking them to quit TMC and form a 'new TMC'. Who will build this new TMC? Those who have been with the party since the beginning, or those who won on the

party symbol," she asked, adding "Do not run a bulldozer over democracy... Do not scare our MLAs and MPs. Do not arrest our people. People are committing suicide due to your atrocities."

Referring to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, she said, "Look at what you have given the responsibility to." "Look at what is happening in West Bengal. You have to look into all of this," she said, indirectly referring to Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari.

"Modi has left Bengal in the hands of anti-socials and bulldozer-happy politicians, pushing the state into darkness."

Vowing to defeat the BJP, the TMC supremo said all the "anti-BJP parties" would soon formulate a country-wide opposition

programme. "Very soon, all anti-BJP parties will meet in Delhi," she said, referring to the INDIA bloc's June 8 meeting.

"I share good relations with all political parties except the BJP. However, I have also stood by those BJP members who asked for help.... Jiyeenge toh BJP ko hataake jayenge (If I remain alive, I will ensure the defeat of the BJP)," she said.

Earlier in the day, she left her Kalighat residence around 2 pm and reached Red Road, where she garlanded the statue of BR Ambedkar. She was accompanied by party leaders Madan Mitra, Kunal Ghosh, Kalyan Banerjee, Dola Sen, and Ashima Patra. From there, she headed straight to the TMC dharna march at Y-Channel, where police were on high alert.

CEMENT IS THE physical grammar of development and remains indispensable to modern life. It is the foundation of the infrastructure that shelters billions, fortifying our defenses against natural disaster and providing a resilient infrastructure for transport, and industry.

As our planet hurtles towards a point of no return vis-à-vis global warming, every sector is working towards reversing this climate emergency by drawing up a contingency plan for curbing its carbon trail, and the cement industry has established itself as a frontrunner in driving efficiency measures and setting ambitious net zero targets.

We are faced with the challenge of making available cement in large volumes, the most significant building material for climate resilient infrastructure, but with the least possible climatic impact. This can only be possible if we can achieve growth sustainably with lower specific CO2 emissions. By continuously deploying the Best Available Technology (BAT), the industry fosters resilient and modern manufacturing.

The Indian cement industry has shown efficiency at scale. It ranks among the most carbon-efficient globally, with some of the lowest specific CO2 emissions per tonne of cement, among the highest energy efficiencies, and extensive utilisation of industrial by-products.



Today, the industry generates more than 1,000 MW of electricity through waste heat recovery systems that consume no fossil fuels.

The cement industry has been the first mover with regard to keeping pace with changing socio-economic and environmental paradigms, whether it is the adoption of new technologies, adhering to stricter environmental standards or utilising other industries' by-products.

It is also aligned with the *Suachh Bharat Mission*. Thus, it serves three objectives: making our cities clean, reducing the landfills and related environmental hazards, and helps in the substitution of fossil fuels and reducing CO2 emissions.

Although the sector has largely captured energy-efficiency gains, deep abatement must come from fuel shift, renewable energy, clinker substitution, and carbon capture, utilisation, and storage and thus, visualising the future, India's commitment to being net zero by 2070 unfolds new dimensions. Such initiatives, however, require support of creating carbon markets, concessional green finance, green public procurement, strong incentives for R&D on innovative and disruptive technologies, to make them more attractive and viable.

The cement industry is where the circular economy moves from theory to practice. Across India, cement plants are replacing conventional fossil fuels with waste-derived alternatives such as Refuse-Derived Fuel (RDF) and non-recyclable plastic waste, while incorporating fly ash and blast furnace slag as supplementary cementitious materials. The industry has transitioned from the traditional "take-make-dispose" model to the regenerative principles of a

circular economy. This shift prioritises the recycling and reuse of materials and energy, reducing waste and enhancing resource efficiency.

For an annual cement production of 490 MT, the industry consumes nearly 150 MT of other industries by-products apart from approximately 10% of thermal substitution from alternate fuels derived from municipal solid wastes and various industrial combustible wastes — thereby, the industry acts as a massive waste management hub, reducing landfill pressure and dependence on virgin natural resources.

A few policy wrinkles, however, need to be ironed out to further enhance wastes utilisation, including priority allocation of fly ash to the industry, strengthening the Polluter Pays Principle, collaborative efforts with waste generators and municipalities for alternative fuels pre-processing for improving the quality of alternative fuels.

The sector is also a vital revenue generator for the central and state governments. The

cement industry is amongst the largest revenue contributor to the exchequer and the railways.

Today, the industry stands at the forefront of transformative change. By integrating green energy, adopting circular economy principles, and leveraging technological innovation, the sector is shaping a future where economic growth aligns with environmental sustainability. The industry is investing in latest technologies and innovative solutions to lower carbon emissions by reducing dependence on fossil fuels and achieve higher energy efficiency.

The government's thrust in this effort is reflected in the FY27 Union Budget financial outlay of ₹20,000 crore over five years to scale CCUS technologies across five industrial sectors, including cement, steel, and power, highlighting its commitment to invest in cost-efficient indigenous technologies.

The deepening collaboration between industry and policymakers is the bedrock of ensuring this sustainable transition. In this transformation, the cement sector is, therefore, justified in demanding a fundamental shift in narrative: from being viewed as a hard-to-abate industry, it stands to be recognised as the critical enabler of industrial decarbonisation itself. Although the road ahead presents challenges, the industry is well positioned to drive meaningful progress and contribute to India's vision of a net zero future.

India, US start final round of talks

ON MONDAY, COMMERCE and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said he was confident that the first tranche of the bilateral trade agreement with the US would be concluded "as soon as possible". He said once this deal is signed, further discussion would commence on a comprehensive Bilateral Trade Agreement (BTA).

Under the framework, the US had agreed to reduce additional reciprocal: tariffs on India over MFN rates to 18% from 50% with India agreeing on zero duty for industrial products from the US and

expressing an intention to buy \$ 500 billion worth of goods from the world's largest economy in the next five years.

However, before the framework could be converted into a formal agreement, the US Supreme Court invalidated the country-specific reciprocal tariffs, which was the starting point

of all trade deals that the US had foisted on its trade partners.

After the US Supreme Court verdict the US had imposed 10% additional tariffs on all trade partners from February 24 under Section 122 of the Trade Act. These tariffs can only be imposed for 150 days and these are expected to expire on July 24.

The US opened two investigations under Section 301 of the Trade Act - one on extra capacities and the other one on the use of forced labour. Post investigation, the US can impose additional duties on the countries that are being probed.

जल वितरण सुधार और जल हानि में कमी करने का अभियान शुरू

रेशनालाइजेशन प्रोजेक्ट के माध्यम से यह सुनिश्चित करेंगे कि दिल्ली के प्रत्येक नागरिक को, चाहे वह किसी भी क्षेत्र में रहता हो, पानी की समान और न्यायसंगत उपलब्धता मिले। उन्होंने बताया कि इस परियोजना के तहत विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में जनसंख्या घनत्व, जल मांग, उपलब्ध आपूर्ति और मौजूदा अवसंरचना का वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन किया जाएगा। इसका उद्देश्य ऐसी संतुलित एवं दक्ष जल वितरण व्यवस्था विकसित करना है, जिससे किसी भी क्षेत्र को पानी की कमी का सामना न करना पड़े और उपलब्ध संसाधनों का बेहतर उपयोग हो सके। मंत्री प्रवेश साहिव सिंह ने कहा कि दिल्ली की जल वितरण प्रणाली के समक्ष सबसे बड़ी चुनौतियों में से एक पुरानी पाइपलाइन व्यवस्था है। उन्होंने कहा कि दिल्ली के 16,634 किलोमीटर लंबे जल वितरण नेटवर्क में से लगभग 5,500 किलोमीटर पाइपलाइन 30 वर्ष से अधिक पुरानी हैं। इन पुरानी पाइपलाइनों में रिसाव और प्रदूषण की संभावना अधिक रहती है, जिससे बड़ी मात्रा में शोधित पानी उपभोक्ताओं तक पहुंचने से पहले ही नष्ट हो जाता है। हमने इन पाइपलाइनों को बदलने और पूरे वितरण नेटवर्क को मजबूत बनाने का अभियान शुरू किया है। उन्होंने कहा कि पिछले वर्षों में आवश्यक जल अवसंरचना में पर्याप्त निवेश नहीं हुआ, जिसके कारण वर्तमान चुनौतियां पैदा हुई हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि जो कार्य 10 या 20 वर्ष पहले हो जाना चाहिए था, उसे अब प्राथमिकता के आधार पर किया जा रहा है। पुरानी पाइपलाइनों का प्रतिस्थापन, रिसाव में कमी, वितरण प्रणाली का आधुनिकीकरण और जल अवसंरचना को मजबूत करना दिल्ली की जल सुरक्षा के लिए अत्यंत आवश्यक है। मंत्री ने बताया कि दिल्ली जल बोर्ड जल वितरण नेटवर्क में होने वाली नॉन-रेवेन्यू वॉटर (एनआरवॉटर) अर्थात् रिसाव, चोरी और तकनीकी खामियों के कारण होने वाले जल नुकसान को कम करने के लिए भी कई परियोजनाओं पर काम कर रहा है। उन्होंने कहा कि सरकार डीएसबी नहर को खुली नहर प्रणाली से बंद पाइपलाइन आधारित प्रणाली में बदलने की संभावना पर भी काम कर रहा है। उन्होंने कहा कि वर्तमान में डीएसबी नहर प्रणाली में लगभग 40 से 45 प्रतिशत पानी का नुकसान हो जाता है। इस समस्या के समाधान के लिए आईआईटी रुड़की से व्यवहारगत अध्ययन करा जा रहा है। नहर को पाइपलाइन आधारित प्रणाली में परिवर्तित किए जाने के बाद जल हानि में भारी कमी आएगी और आपूर्ति की दक्षता में उल्लेखनीय सुधार होगा। अवसंरचना सुधारों के साथ-साथ दिल्ली सरकार जल संरक्षण और जल पुनर्चक्रण पर आधारित दीर्घकालिक रणनीति भी लागू कर रही है। इसके तहत ड्यूल पाइपिंग सिस्टम को बढ़ावा दिया जाएगा।

दिल्ली की लगभग 12 से 13 विधानसभा क्षेत्रों से हर वर्ष गर्मियों में सबसे अधिक जल संबंधी शिकायतें प्राप्त होती हैं, जबकि कुछ क्षेत्रों में अपेक्षाकृत अधिक जल आपूर्ति होती है। यह असंतुलन वर्षों से बना हुआ है। अब हम हार्डवैट
